#### VISIT OF SHAYKH IMADUDEEN ABU HIJLEH

Our association organized the visit of Shayk Imadudeen Abu Hijleh to Sri Lanka from 14<sup>th</sup> January to 12<sup>th</sup> February 2013. A renowned Islamic scholar he hails from the Quraishi family of Abu Ubaidah al Jarrah originally from Jordan and presently living in Tarim, Yemen Shaykh Imad is the founder of the Al Razi Institute in Boston, Masachussets from where many students who completed their studies have gone on to start institutions of their own. He has taught at Harvard University and authored many books covering various Islamic topics such as Aqidah, Fiqh, Zakat, Fasting and Spirituality. His work on Shafie Fiqh is widely used by many scholars around the world.

Shayk Imad has studied many classical books in the Shariah sciences and has received ijaaza or permission to teach in these sciences as well as chains of transmissions that trace back to Holy Prophet Muhammed (PBUH). He has started dawah programs around the world. Currently he is writing an Encyclopoedia of Fiqh that will address many modern issues and problems faced all over the world.

During his stay in Sri Lanka he visited many places in Colombo and other parts of the country. He delivered lectures, Kuthba sermons, had consultations and Q & A sessions and participated in many functions organized by Muslim associations.
